


FTSE Developed Europe ex UK Factor Enhanced Target Dividend Index

The FTSE Developed Europe ex UK Factor Enhanced Target Dividend Index is a part of the FTSE Global Target Dividend Index Series. It is designed to achieve 80% dividend yield increase compared to its underlying index—FTSE Developed Europe ex UK Index, while balancing quality active factor exposure, and addressing concerns about turnover, yield trap, concentration, capacity and diversification.

The FTSE Global Target Dividend Index Series is designed to reflect the performance of stocks representing a specific set of factor characteristics, with a particular focus on implementing dividend yield (a non-factor exposure) uplift target vs. the representative base universe. The index constituent weightings are determined using the FTSE Target Exposure methodology under the FTSE Global Factor Index Series.

Objective

The index is designed for use in the creation of index tracking funds, derivatives and as a performance benchmark.

Stocks are selected and weighted to ensure that the index is investable.

Liquidity

Stocks are screened to ensure that the index is tradable.

Transparency

Index methodologies are freely available on the FTSE Russell website.

Availability

The index is calculated based on price and total return methodologies, both real time and end of day. Net of tax indexes are also available.

Index constituents are categorized in accordance with the Industry Classification Benchmark (ICB), the global standard for industry sector analysis.
