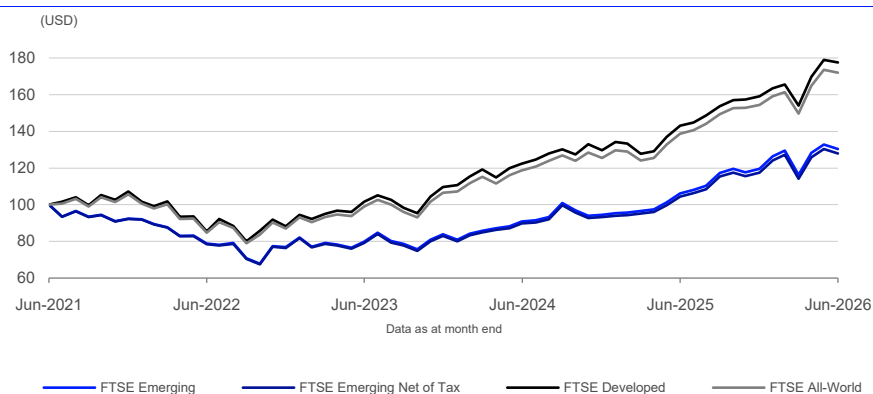

The index is derived from the FTSE Global Equity Index Series (GEIS), which covers 99% of the world's investable market capitalisation.

The index is calculated based on price and total return methodologies, both real time and end of day. Net of tax indexes are also available.

Index constituents are categorized in accordance with the Industry Classification Benchmark (ICB), the global standard for industry sector analysis.
