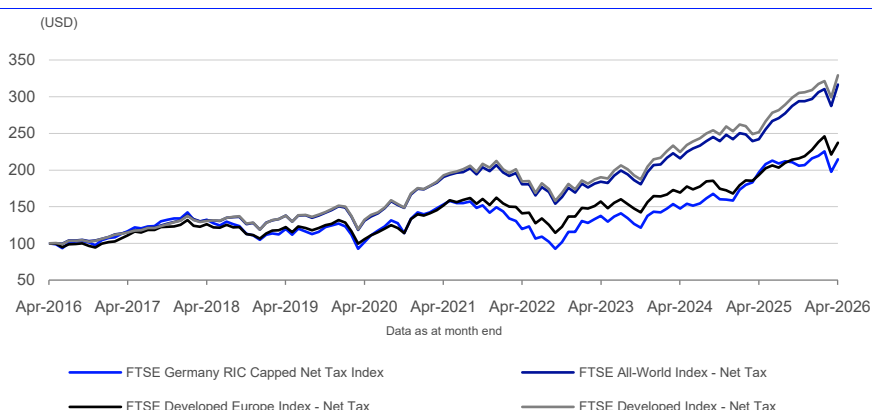


FTSE Germany RIC Capped Index

The FTSE Global RIC Capped Indexes are market-capitalization weighted indexes designed to limit concentration in any single security to help users meet the Regulated Investment Company (RIC) concentration requirements for US registered funds. The FTSE Global RIC Capped Indexes are a subset of the FTSE Global Equity Index Series (GEIS), which covers 99% of the world's investable market capitalization. The FTSE Germany RIC Capped Index represents the performance of German large and mid capitalization stocks. Securities are weighted based on their free float-adjusted market capitalization and reviewed semi-annually. To limit over concentration in any single security, constituents are capped quarterly so that no more than 20% of the index's weight may be allocated to a single constituent and the sum of the weights of all constituents representing more than 4.5% of the index should not exceed 48% of the total index weight.

FEATURES

Coverage

Derived from the FTSE Global Equity Index Series (GEIS), which covers 98% of the world's investable market capitalisation.

Objective

The index is designed for use in the creation of index tracking funds, derivatives and as a performance benchmark.

Investability

Stocks are selected and weighted to ensure that the index is investable.

Liquidity

Stocks are screened to ensure that the index is tradable.

Capping

To limit over concentration in any single security, constituents are capped quarterly so that no more than 20% of the indexes weight may be allocated to a single constituent and the sum of the weights of all constituents representing more than 4.5% of the index should not exceed 48% of the total index weight.

Transparency

The index uses a transparent, rules-based construction process. Index Methodologies are freely available on the FTSE Russell website.

Availability

The index is calculated based on price and total return methodologies, both real time and end of day. Net of tax indexes are also available.

Industry Classification Benchmark (ICB)

Index constituents are categorized in accordance with the Industry Classification Benchmark (ICB), the global standard for industry sector analysis.
