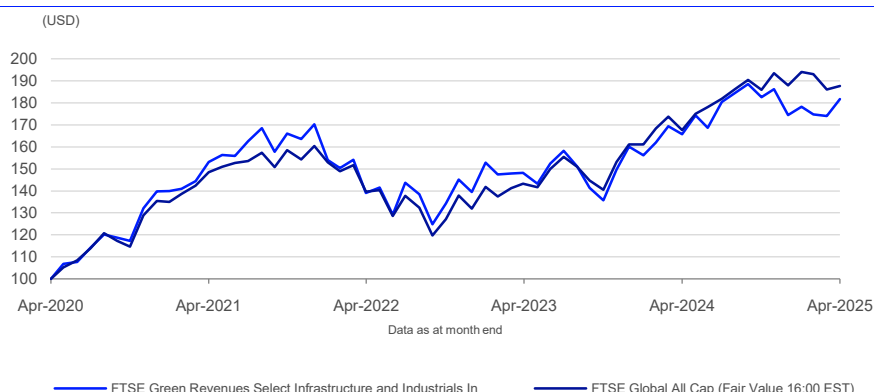


FTSE Green Revenues Select Infrastructure and Industrials Index

Data as at: 30 April 2025

The FTSE Green Revenues Select Infrastructure and Industrials Index measures the performance of global companies in the industrials, utilities, and basic materials sectors that provide solutions aiming to support energy efficiency and emissions mitigation, pollution reduction or land and resource optimization. The index requires companies to have at least 40% of their revenues derived from eligible green infrastructure and industrials solutions based on FTSE Russell's Green Revenues data model. Companies that are in breach of the UN Global Compact (UNGC), or have a defined exposure to controversial weapons, small arms, tobacco, oil sands and thermal coal are excluded from the index.

Objective

Availability

The index is calculated based on price and total return methodologies, available end of day.

Index constituents are categorized in accordance with the Industry Classification Benchmark (ICB), the global standard for industry sector analysis.
