

Russell 1000 TPI Climate Transition Index

Data as at: 28 February 2025

The Russell 1000 TPI Climate Transition Index is designed to reflect the performance of large-cap companies in the US, where constituent weights vary to account for risks and opportunities associated with the transition to a low carbon economy. Constituent weights are based on five key climate considerations: company exposure to green revenues, fossil fuel reserves and carbon emissions; as well as companies' climate governance activities (aligned with the Taskforce on Climate-related Financial Disclosures' recommendations) and forward-looking commitments to carbon emission pathways (aligned to the Paris Agreement and 2DC/1.5DC warming scenarios). The index combines data and analysis from FTSE Russell and the Transition Pathway Initiative (TPI).
