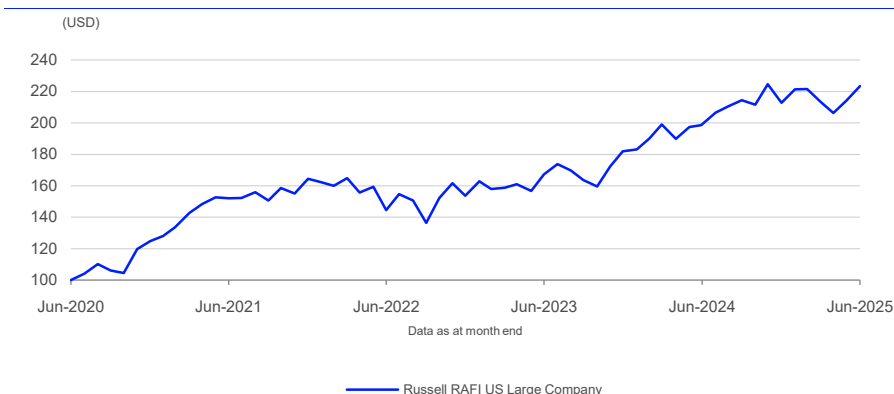


Russell RAFI™ US Large Company Index

Objective
