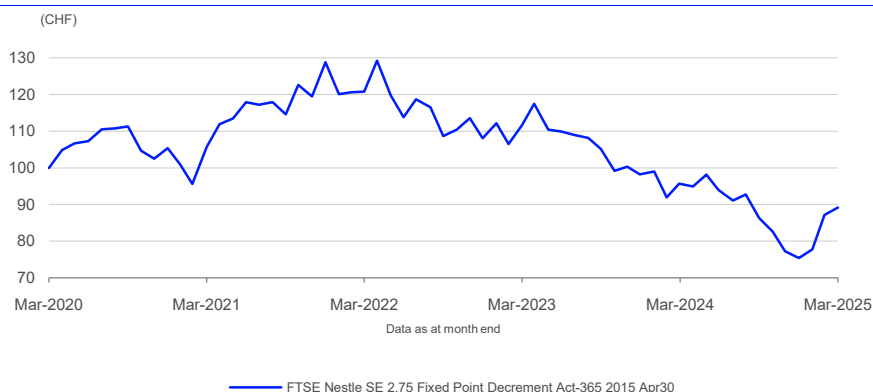


FTSE Nestle SE 2.75 Fixed Point Decrement Act-365 2015 Apr30 Index
