About the index

The Russell 1000® Index measures the performance of the large cap segment of the US equity market. The index includes approximately 1,000 of the largest US companies based on a combination of their market cap and current index membership. The Russell 1000 Index is a subset of the Russell 3000® Index, which was designed to represent approximately 98% of the investable US equity market. The index is reconstituted semi-annually, and newly eligible IPOs are added quarterly, to ensure new and growing companies are represented in this comprehensive and investable US large cap index.

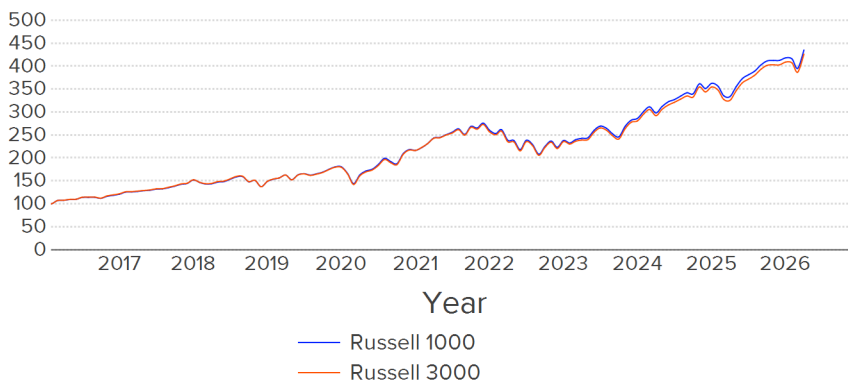

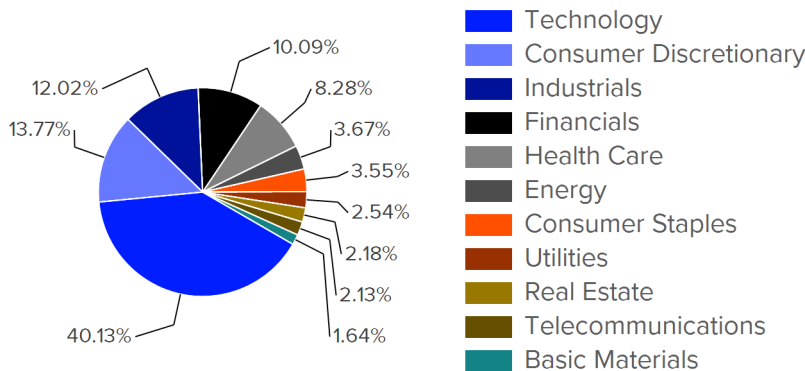
