About the index

The Russell 3000E™ Index includes up to 4,000 of the largest investable US stocks. The index provides the broadest US "extended" equity index, and includes all constituents across the large cap Russell 1000® Index, small cap Russell 2000® Index and Russell Microcap® Index. The Russell 3000E Index is constructed to provide a comprehensive, unbiased and stable barometer of the investable US equity opportunity set. Semi-annual reconstitution and quarterly IPO inclusions ensure newly eligible companies are represented in this comprehensive and investable extended US equity index. IPOs with investable market cap above the Russell Top 500 breakpoint are eligible for fast entry; breakpoints are set semi-annually and market-adjusted quarterly.

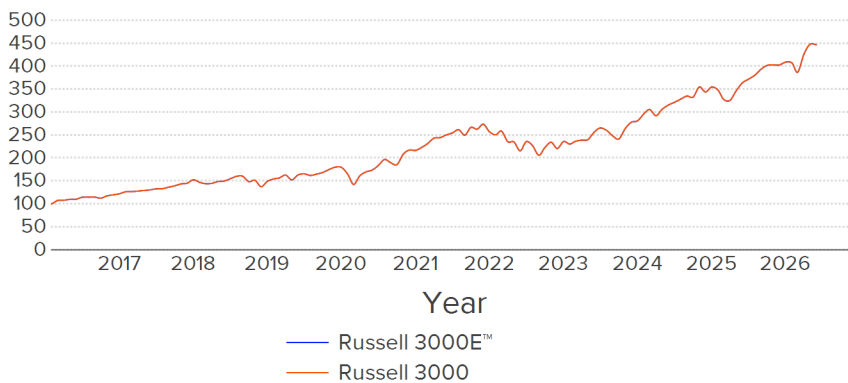

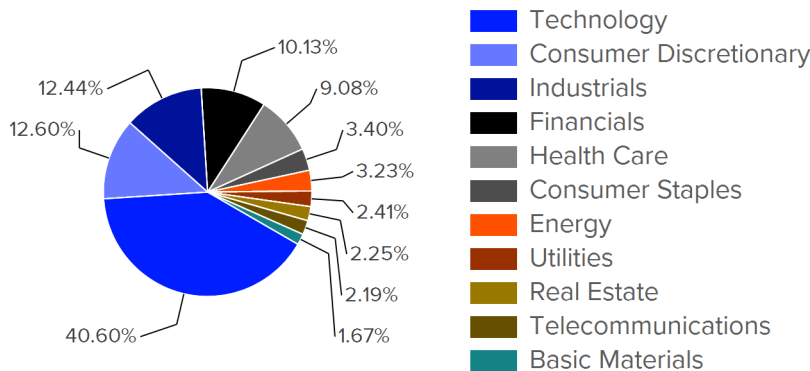
