The Russell Top 50[®] Mega Cap Index measures the performance of the largest 50 US mega cap companies in the Russell 3000 Index. The index includes 50 of the largest companies based on their market cap at reconstitution. The index is reconstituted semi-annually, and newly eligible IPOs are added quarterly, to ensure new and growing companies are represented in the Russell Top 50 Mega Cap Index.

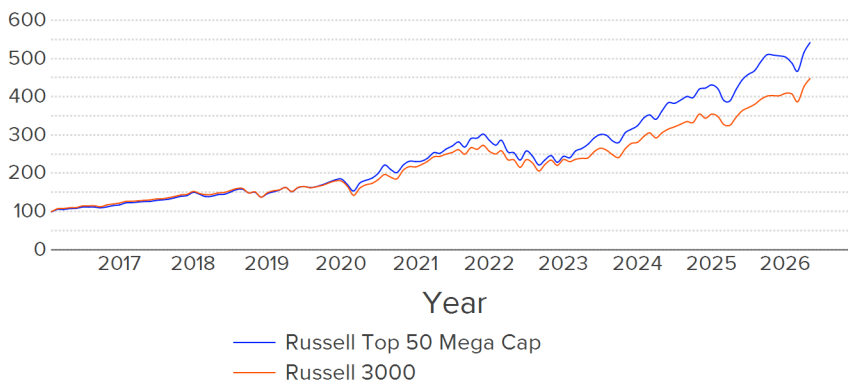

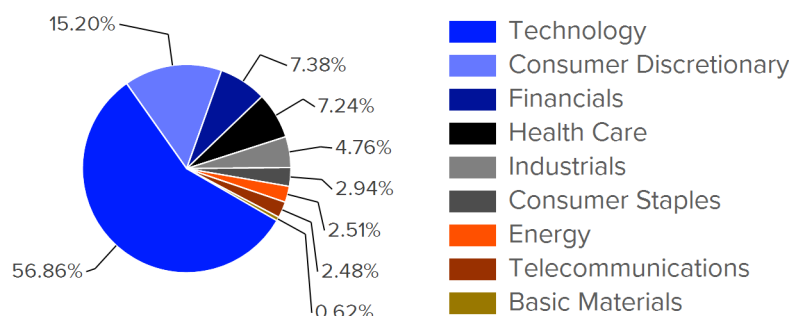
