FEATURES

Coverage

Large, mid and small cap constituents listed on the seven exchanges that make up the ASEAN partnership.

Objective

The majority of the indices can be used as tools for the creation of index tracking funds, derivatives and as a performance benchmark. The FTSE ASEAN Stars Index is intended as a barometer and not to be used as the basis for investment products.

Investability

Stocks are selected and weighted to ensure that the indices are investable.

Liquidity

Stocks are screened to ensure that index components are tradable.

Transparency

Index rules are freely available on the FTSE website.

Availability

The indices are calculated based on price and total return methodologies, both real time (FTSE/ASEAN 40 only) and end-of-day.

Industry Classification Benchmark

Index constituents are categorized in accordance with the Industry Classification Benchmark (ICB), the global standard for industry sector analysis.
