About the index

The Russell 2000® Index measures the performance of the small cap segment of the US equity market. The index includes approximately 2,000 of the smallest companies based on a combination of their market cap and current index membership. The Russell 2000 Index is a subset of the Russell 3000® Index, which was designed to represent approximately 98% of the investable US equity market. Semi-annual reconstitution and quarterly IPO inclusions ensure newly eligible companies are represented and that larger stocks do not distort the performance and characteristics of the true US small cap opportunity set.

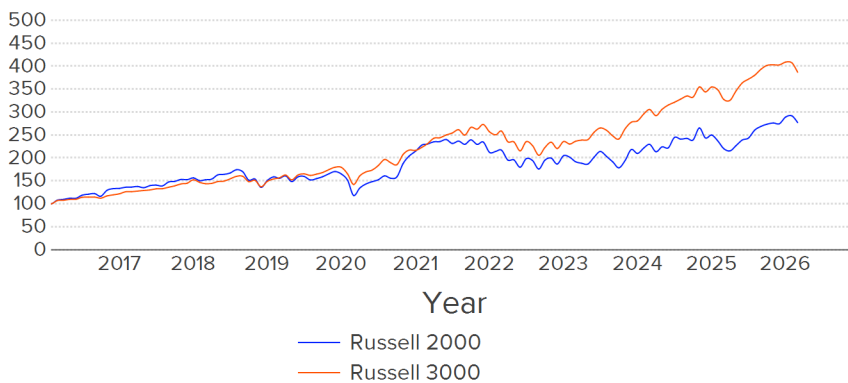

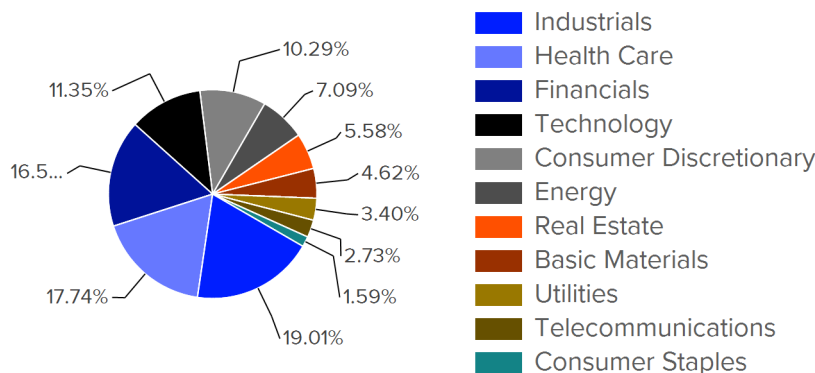
