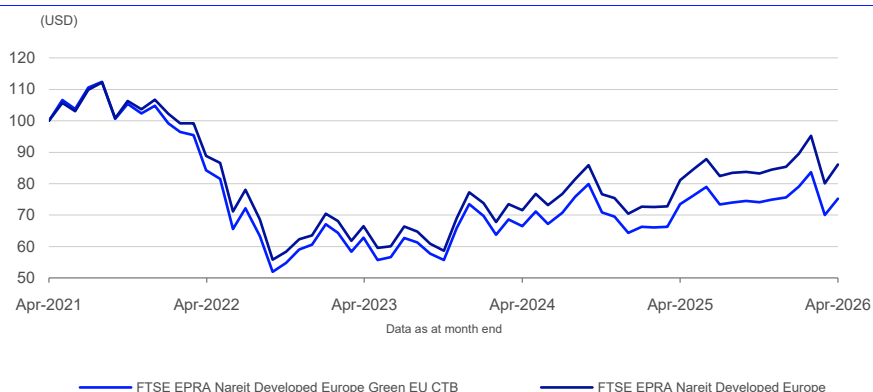


FTSE EPRA Nareit Developed Europe Green EU CTB Index

Data as at: 30 April 2026

The FTSE EPRA Nareit Developed Europe Green EU CTB Index supports investors wanting to integrate sustainable investment considerations into their listed real estate portfolio. The index is comprised of constituents of the FTSE EPRA Nareit Developed Europe Index and is designed to align EU Benchmark Regulation for Climate Transition Benchmarks (CTB). It applies conduct and product involvement-related exclusions and incorporates the following targets: 30% GHG emissions intensity reduction, 7% minimum average GHG emissions intensity reduction relative to previous year after inception, 30% Green certificate increase, 10% energy consumption reduction. Furthermore, industry banding constraints are applied to the index in order to reduce tracking error. The index uses GHG and green real estate data from Measurabl, as well as Transition Pathway Initiative (TPI) Management Quality scores.

Availability

The index is calculated based on price and total return methodologies, available end-of-day.

Property Sector Classification

Constituents are classified into distinct Property Sectors based on gross invested book assets as disclosed in the latest published financial statement.
