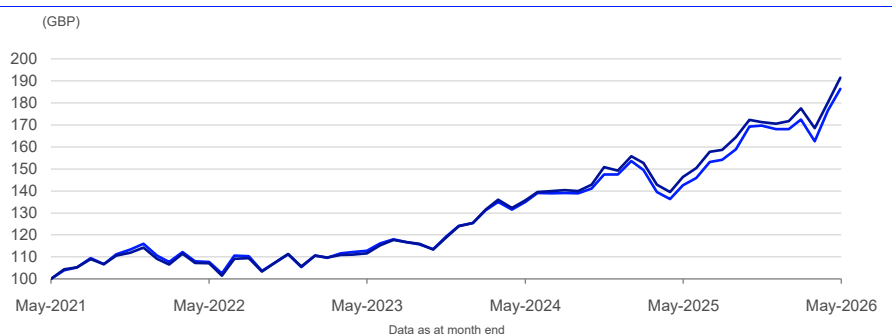


FTSE Developed TPI Climate Transition ex Coal Reserves (>50%) ex Controversies ex Nuclear ex Tobacco

The FTSE Developed TPI Climate Transition ex Coal Reserves (>50%) ex Controversies ex Nuclear ex Tobacco Index tracks a global basket of securities with constituent weights adjusted for climate-related risks and opportunities. Weighting considers exposure to green revenues, fossil fuel reserves, carbon emissions, climate governance, and alignment with the Paris Agreement. Data from FTSE Russell and the Transition Pathway Initiative (TPI) is combined and applies exclusions in line with FTSE's set of minimum exclusions and the following categories: >50% ownership of coal reserves, controversial conduct, nuclear weapons, and tobacco.
