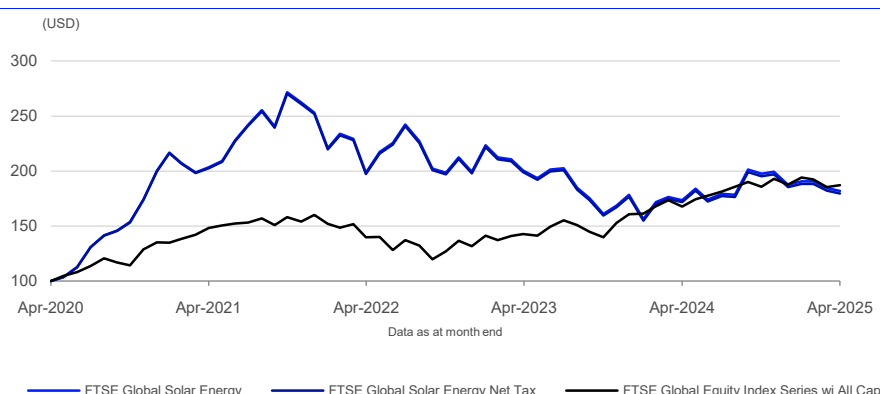


FTSE Global Solar Energy Index

The FTSE Global Solar Energy Index is a liquidity-weighted thematic index based on the FTSE Global All Cap Index which includes large, mid, and small-cap securities globally. The index employs natural language processing techniques in selecting constituents associated with the underlying theme. The index is designed to represent the performance of companies that research, develop, utilize, or provide product or services that related to solar energy.

FEATURES

Objective

The index is designed for use in the creation of index tracking funds, derivatives and as a performance benchmark.

Capping

Constituents are capped quarterly in March, June, September and December so that no more than 5% of the indexes weight may be allocated to a single constituent.

Investability

Stocks are selected and weighted to ensure that the index is investable.

Liquidity

Stocks are screened to ensure that the index is tradable.

Transparency

Index methodologies are freely available on the FTSE Russell website.

Availability

The index is calculated based on price and total return methodologies, both real time intra-second and end-of-day.

Industry Classification Benchmark (ICB)

Index constituents are categorized in accordance with the Industry Classification Benchmark (ICB), the global standard for industry sector analysis.
