

FTSE Italy SMID Cap Tradable Plus Index

The FTSE Italy SMID Cap Tradable Plus Index is a rapidly tradable index that encapsulates the behaviour of the small- and mid-cap (SMID) Italy equity market. By design, the index has a limited number of highly liquid constituents, allowing easy market access, while maintaining FTSE Russell's tradition of rules-based, transparent index construction. Its innovative approach to constituent selection ensures easy and rapid trading of each underlying constituent and of the investable products based on the index as a whole, and a broad representation of stocks from across the capitalisation range.

Objective

Stocks in the underlying index are selected and weighted to ensure that the index is investable.

Stocks are screened to ensure that the index is tradable.

Index methodologies are freely available on the FTSE Russell website.

Availability

The index is calculated based on price and total return methodologies, both real time and end of day.
