


FTSE World North America Index

The FTSE World North America Index is one of a range of indexes designed to help investors to benchmark their North American investments. The index comprises Large and Mid cap stocks providing coverage of the Developed and Advanced Emerging markets in North America. The index is derived from the FTSE Global Equity Index Series (GEIS), which covers 98% of the world's investable market capitalisation.

FEATURES

Coverage

Derived from the FTSE Global Equity Index Series (GEIS), which covers 98% of the world's investable market capitalisation.

Objective

The indexes are designed for use in the creation of index tracking funds, derivatives and as a performance benchmark.

Investability

Stocks are selected and weighted to ensure that the indexes are investable.

Liquidity

Stocks are screened to ensure that the indexes are tradable.

Transparency

Index methodologies are freely available on the FTSE Russell website.

Availability

The index is calculated based on price and total return methodologies, available end of day. Net of tax indexes are also available.

Industry Classification Benchmark (ICB)

Index constituents are categorized in accordance with the Industry Classification Benchmark (ICB), the global standard for industry sector analysis.
