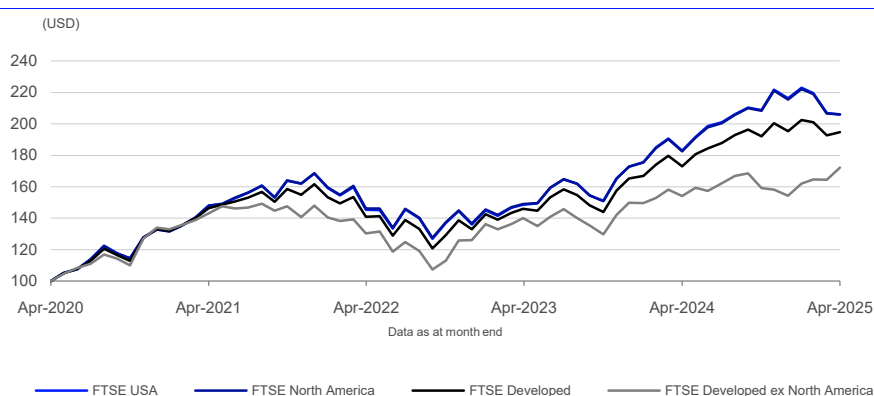


# FTSE USA Index

The FTSE USA Index is part of a range of indices designed to help North American investors benchmark their investments. The FTSE USA Index is a market-capitalisation weighted index representing the performance of US large and mid cap stocks. The index is derived from the FTSE Global Equity Index Series (GEIS), which covers 98% of the world's investable market capitalization.

## FEATURES

### Coverage

Derived from the FTSE Global Equity Index Series (GEIS), which covers 98% of the world's investable market capitalisation.

### Objective

The index is designed for use in the creation of index tracking funds, derivatives and as a performance benchmark.

### Investability

Stocks are selected and weighted to ensure that the index is investable.

### Liquidity

Stocks are screened to ensure that the index is tradable.

### Transparency

Freely available index rules are overseen by an independent committee of leading market professionals.

### Availability

The index is calculated based on price and total return methodologies, both real time and end-of-day.

### Industry Classification Benchmark

Index constituents are categorized in accordance with the Industry Classification Benchmark (ICB), the global standard for industry sector analysis.
