

FTSE US Broad Investment-Grade Impact Bond Index

Multi-Sector | US Dollar

The FTSE US Broad Investment-Grade Impact Bond Index (USBIG Impact) constituents are selected from the FTSE US Broad Investment-Grade Bond Index (USBIG), screened in accordance with the transparent and defined green, social and sustainability (GSS) bond criteria.

The USBIG Impact leverages LSEG Reference Data Services and Climate Bonds Initiative (CBI) data to identify underlying bonds that are in compliance with corresponding international guidelines. Specifically, CBI data is used to identify eligible Green Bonds whose use of proceeds are in line with the Paris Agreement. LSEG Reference Data Services identifies eligible Social and Sustainability Bonds that are in line with the core components of International Capital Markets Association (ICMA) Social Bond Principles (SBP) and/or ICMA Sustainability Bond Guidelines (SBG).


The USBIG Impact is a multi-sector GSS bond benchmark of investment-grade, US Dollar denominated debt issued by US Treasury, government-sponsored, and corporations.




HISTORICAL EFFECTIVE DURATION




HISTORICAL YIELD TO MATURITY

Weighting:	Market capitalization
Universe:	FTSE US Broad Investment-Grade Bond Index
Green Bond Eligibility:	Climate Bonds Initiative (CBI) identifies eligible Green Bonds whose proceeds are specifically earmarked for projects that have environmental and/or climate benefit and are aligned with Paris Agreement
Social Bond Eligibility:	LSEG Reference Data Services identifies eligible Social Bonds that are in line with International Capital Markets Association (ICMA) Social Bond Principles (SBP) and its proceeds are specifically earmarked for projects that have social benefit
Sustainability Bond Eligibility:	LSEG Reference Data Services identifies eligible Sustainability Bonds that are in line with International Capital Markets Association (ICMA) Sustainability Bond Guidelines (SBG) and its proceeds are specifically earmarked for projects that have both green and social benefit
Minimum Maturity:	At least one year
Minimum Quality:	BBB- by S&P or Baa3 by Moody's
Pricing:	LSEG Pricing Service
Rebalancing:	Once a month at month end
Calculation Frequency:	Daily
Settlement Date:	Monthly – Settlement is on the last calendar day of the month. Daily – Same day settlement except if the last business day of the month is not the last calendar day of the month; then, settlement is on the last calendar day of the month.
Fixing Date:	Each month, the upcoming month's index constituents are "fixed" on the profile fixing date. Each year's scheduled fixing dates are published on the website.
