Russell 1000 Growth 40 Act Daily Capped Index

About the index

The Russell 1000® Growth 40 Act Daily Capped Index measures the performance of the Large Cap Growth segment of the US equity universe, with a capping methodology applied. Russell 1000 Growth 40 Act Daily Capped Index is a subset of the Russell 1000 Index and includes those Russell 1000® companies with higher price-to-book ratios and higher forecasted growth values based on a combination of their market cap and current index membership. The Russell 1000 Growth 40 Act Daily Capped Index has been created in consideration of the definition of a "Diversified Company" via section 5(b)(1) of the Investment Company Act of 1940 (40 Act). At the quarterly index reviews, all companies that have a weight greater than 4.5% in aggregate are no more than 22.5% of the index, and no individual company in the index has a weight greater than 22.5% of the index. The index is monitored daily to ensure that constituent weights do not breach 40 Act thresholds.

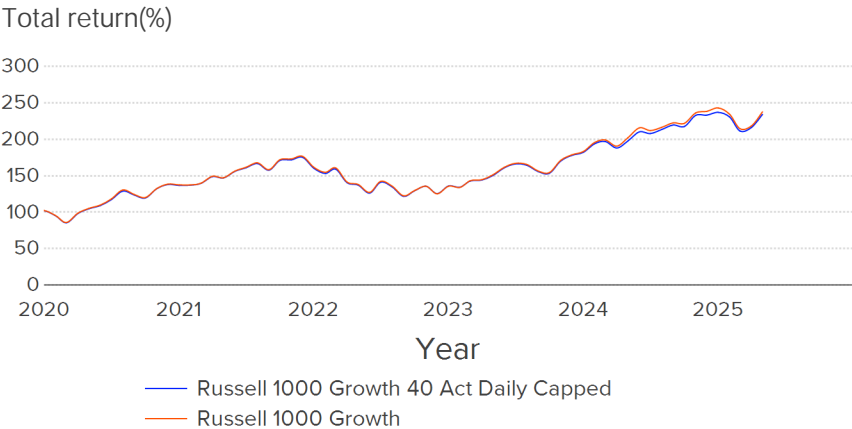

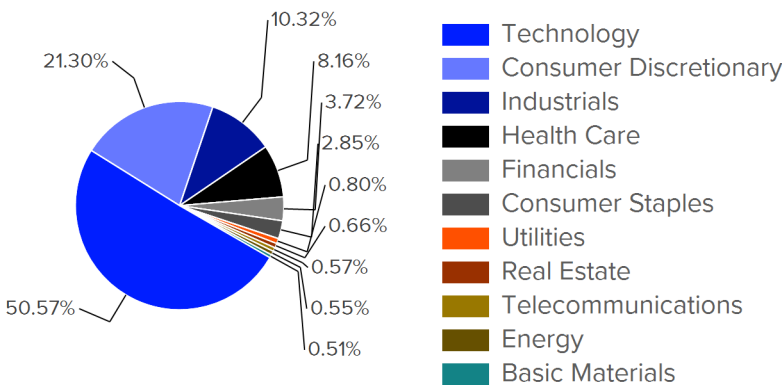
