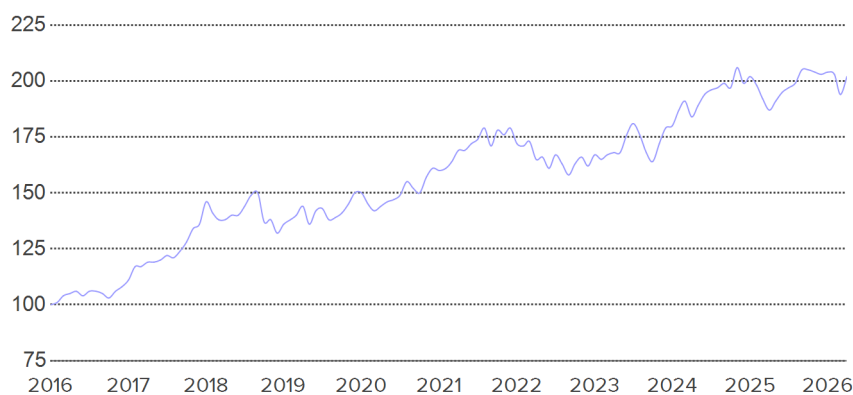


Russell 1000 Fast VT 10% Index

About the index

The Russell 1000 Fast VT 10% Index is an excess return index that adjusts exposure to the underlying index (subject to a cap) on a daily basis proportionally to the ratio between the specified volatility target and the realized volatility of the underlying index. Such dynamic exposure helps achieve a desired level of volatility and is called a “Volatility Control”. The Russell 1000 Fast 10% VT Index uses an intraday mechanism to react quickly to changing market conditions, allowing it to target volatility more precisely and improve risk-adjusted returns and drawdown.
