About the index

The Russell 2500™ Growth-Dynamic Index® measures the performance of the small to mid-cap growth-dynamic segment of the US equity universe. It includes Russell 2500 Index companies with relatively higher price-to-book ratios, higher I/B/E/S forecast medium term (2 year) growth and higher sales per share historical growth (5 years) and relatively less stable business conditions that are more sensitive to economic cycles, credit cycles, and market volatility based on their stability variables. The Russell 2500 Growth-Dynamic Index is constructed to provide a comprehensive, unbiased, and stable barometer of the small to mid-cap growth-dynamic market. The Index is completely reconstituted annually to ensure larger stocks do not distort the performance and characteristics of the true small to mid-cap opportunity set and that the represented companies continue to reflect growth and dynamic characteristics.

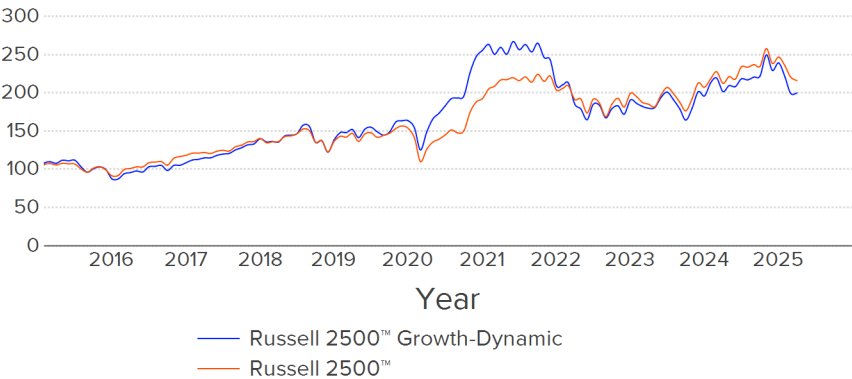

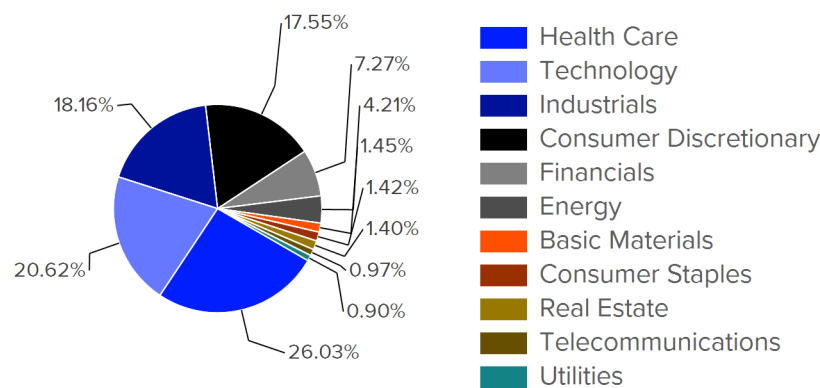
