

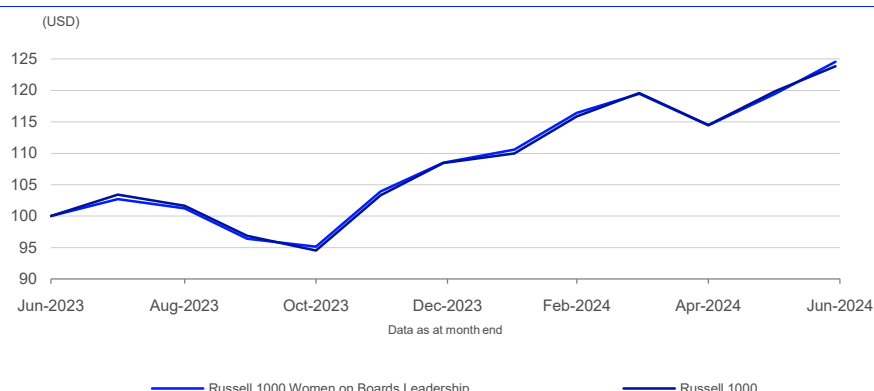
Russell 1000 Women on Boards Leadership Index

The Russell 1000 Women on Boards Leadership Index is designed to integrate leadership in gender diversity into a broad market benchmark. This index increases exposure to companies based on the strength of their diversity leadership at the Boards level and how well they manage wider impacts on society. This is achieved by the use of a tilt (or stock weight adjustment) to integrate gender diversity and social impact.

The Russell 1000 Women on Boards Leadership Index can be used to assist in the integration of gender diversity and social considerations into a diversified investment strategy. This index also provides a strong basis for corporate engagement by highlighting those companies that demonstrate leadership in these two areas. Thus, the Russell 1000 Women on Boards Leadership Index contributes to the gender diversity movement to promote awareness and improve inclusive environments at all levels.

FEATURES

Objective

The index is designed for use in the creation of index tracking funds, derivatives and as a performance benchmark.

Investability

Stocks are selected and weighted to ensure that the index is investable.

Liquidity

Stocks are screened to ensure that the index is tradable.

Transparency

The index uses a transparent, rules-based construction process. Index methodologies are freely available on the FTSE Russell website.

Availability

The index is calculated based on price and total return methodologies, available end of day.

Industry Classification Benchmark (ICB)

Index constituents are categorized in accordance with the Industry Classification Benchmark (ICB), the global standard for industry sector analysis.
