

# Russell 1000 Value-Dynamic Index

## About the index

The Russell 1000® Value-Dynamic Index® measures the performance of the large-cap value-dynamic segment of the US equity universe. It includes Russell 1000 Index companies with relatively lower price-to-book ratios, lower I/B/E/S forecast medium term (2 year) growth and lower sales per share historical growth (5 years) and relatively less stable business conditions that are more sensitive to economic cycles, credit cycles, and market volatility based on their stability variables. Stability is measured in terms of volatility (price and earnings), leverage, and return on assets. The Russell 1000 Value-Dynamic Index is constructed to provide a comprehensive, unbiased, and stable barometer of the large-cap value-dynamic market. The Index is completely reconstituted annually to ensure new and growing equities are included and that the represented companies continue to reflect value and dynamic characteristics.

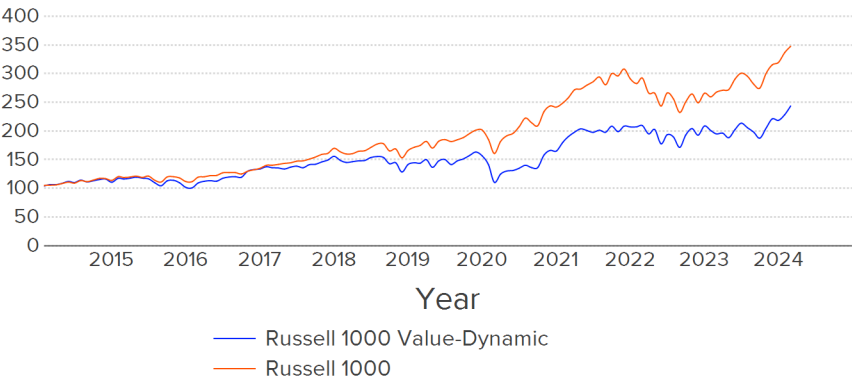

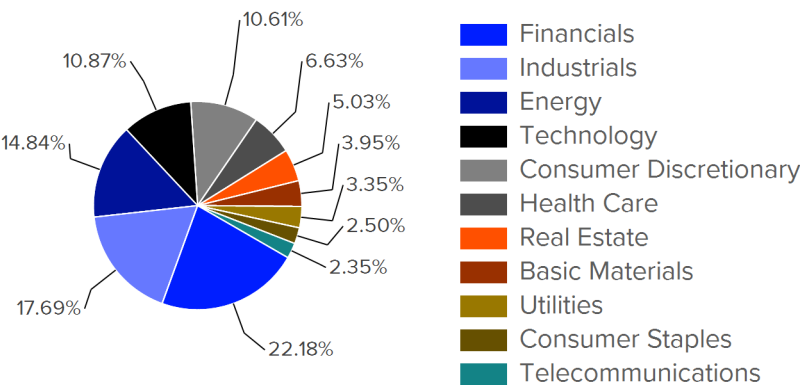
