

FTSE ONLINE PRIVACY POLICY STATEMENT

FTSE International Limited ("FTSE") takes the privacy of its users seriously. We are committed to safeguarding the privacy of our users while providing a personalised and valuable service. This Privacy Policy explains the data processing practices of FTSE. We appreciate that you do not want your personal information distributed and used indiscriminately, and here we explain how we collect information via www.ftse.com (the "Site"), what we do with it and what your rights are in relation to that information.

FTSE is registered as a data controller in accordance with United Kingdom Data Protection Act 1998. We will process any personal information we collect about you in accordance with the Data Protection Act 1998.

Additionally, if you have any requests concerning your personal information, wish to make any amendment to your personal information or have any queries with regard to our practices then please contact Client Services at info@ftse.com.

Information collected

We collect personal information from you at registration and other times (for instance, when you enter into a contract with FTSE) such as your name, email address, postal address and telephone number.

You are under no obligation to provide us with such information. However, if you choose to withhold requested information, we may not be able to respond effectively to your query or provide you with certain services.

Use of personal information

We process personal information collected via the Site for the purposes of:

- conducting market consultation exercises; and
- providing you with information about products and services offered by FTSE.

We may occasionally also send you direct mail by email, post or fax about FTSE products and services which may be of interest to you. This will only come from us (or one of the companies within the FTSE group) and only if you have indicated that you wish to receive these offers, either at initial registration, when you are subsequently contacted or through updates or amendments to your personal information. When you receive such direct mail, you will have the opportunity to opt-out of receiving further direct mails from FTSE.

Disclosure of personal information

We do not disclose your information to any third parties other than those within the FTSE group of companies.

We also use information in aggregate form (so that no individual user is identified):

- to build up marketing profiles
- to aid strategic development
- to manage our relationship with advertisers; and
- to audit usage of the site.

FTSE reserves the right to disclose personal information if required to do so by law or if we believe that it is necessary to do so to protect and defend the rights, property or personal safety of FTSE, the Site, or its visitors.

Links

This Site may contain links to other sites. We cannot be responsible for the privacy policies and practices of other web sites even if you access them using links from our web site and we recommend you check the privacy policy of each site you visit. Use of cookies

We use cookies to improve the quality of our site and service, and to try and make your browsing experience meaningful. A number of cookies we use last only for the duration of your web session and expire when you close your browser. Other cookies are used to remember you when you return to the site and will last for a longer duration.

Where the information is stored
