



FTSE EU Climate Benchmarks Index Series - Ground Rule Update

FTSE Russell would like to inform clients of the following update to the FTSE EU Climate Benchmarks Index Series Ground Rules which is effective immediately.

Following the proposal in the [02 September 2022](#) notice, the FTSE EU Climate Benchmark Index Series Ground Rules have been updated.

Commission Delegated Regulation (EU) 2020/1818¹ regarding minimum standards for EU Climate Transition Benchmarks and EU Paris-aligned Benchmarks requires the phasing-in of scope 3 carbon emissions according to the calendar outlined in Article 5 of the regulation. Given this context, FTSE Russell has updated the FTSE EU Climate Benchmarks Index Series methodology to incorporate scope 3 emissions data.
