The above nationality changes will become effective after the close of business on Friday, 20 March 2026 (i.e., on Monday, 23 March 2026).

The Schiehallion Fund, KR1 PLC and Cindrigo Holdings, have been assigned a UK nationality in accordance to rule 1.5 and 1.6 of the Determining Nationality guide.

Diversified Energy Company, has its nationality re-assessed under rule 1.4 of the Determining Nationality guide, Diversified Energy Company will change nationality status from UK to USA.

STMicroelectronics NV, has its nationality re-assessed under rule 1.7 of the Determining Nationality guide, STMicroelectronics NV will change nationality status from France to Italy.

Bajaj Mobility AG, has its nationality re-assessed under rule 1.4 of the Determining Nationality guide, Bajaj Mobility AG will change nationality status from Switzerland to Austria.

GFH Financial Group BSC, has its nationality re-assessed under rule 1.7 of the Determining Nationality guide, GFH Financial Group BSC will change nationality status from UAE to Kuwait.

Galaxy Digital Inc, has its nationality re-assessed under rule 1.4 of the Determining Nationality guide, Galaxy Digital Inc will change nationality status from Canada to USA.

Southern Cross Gold Consolidated, has its nationality re-assessed under rule 1.4 of the Determining Nationality guide, Southern Cross Gold Consolidated will change nationality status from Australia to Canada.

Please note:

Further to the notice published on **05 August 2025**, **James Hardie Industries** (AU, B60QWJ2) continues to be assessed under rule 1.9 of the Determining Nationality guidelines. Should this result in a change to nationality it will be communicated at a subsequent scheduled nationality review.

The above table confirms nationality assignment only. Potential inclusion to the FTSE Global Equity Index Series or the FTSE UK Index Series will be subject to the security passing all other index eligibility criteria (including minimum liquidity requirements) as detailed in the respective ground rules. Index entry will be confirmed within the periodic index review notices announcing constituent changes.

However, where a company has been identified as failing the initial security eligibility criteria, such as not meeting the listing requirement for the FTSE UK Index Series or being assigned an ICB classification which is ineligible for the FTSE Global Equity Index Series, then it will be flagged as ineligible within the above table and will not be considered for index inclusion.
