

ZTE Corp. (China): Stock Suspension Treatment in FTSE Indices

ZTE Corp. (China, B04KP88) was suspended from trading on the Hong Kong Stock Exchange on 17 April 2018, pending the further release of an announcement regarding a denial order issued by the Bureau of Industry and Security of the United States Department of Commerce.

In conjunction with the FTSE suspended companies rule, the company will be retained in the index based on its last traded price.

FTSE will continue to monitor the case and review the company's eligibility for index inclusion pending further information.
