

FTSE TWSE Taiwan Dividend+ Index Market Consultation – Results and Next Steps

FTSE Russell thanks all index users and stakeholders who responded to the FTSE TWSE Taiwan Dividend+ Index Market Consultation.

Following the receipt of supportive feedback from market participants and the subsequent approval of the proposal by FTSE Russell's Index Governance Board, FTSE Russell confirms that the number of constituents in the FTSE TWSE Taiwan Dividend+ Index will be increased from 30 to 50.

The implementation of this proposal will take place as follows:

- The increase to the number of constituents will be made on a 'one-off' basis, effective from the December 2022 semi-annual review.
- The limit of five additions and five deletions at each semi-annual review, as outlined in section 4.2.7 of the Ground Rules, will be temporarily suspended for December 2022 semi-annual review to allow FTSE Russell to execute the change to the number of constituents. The limits will be reinstated after the increase to the constituents has taken place.
- The review changes will continue to be implemented over five consecutive trading days, as outlined in 4.5.1 of the Ground Rules.
- Updated ground rules reflecting the new number of constituents will be published in due course.
